### FINANCIAL LITERACY FOR .50 CREDIT

- THIS FOUR WEEK COURSE MEETS OHIO'S FINANCIAL LITERACY GRADUATION REQUIREMENT. UNITS OF STUDY INCLUDE MONEY MANAGEMENT AND BUDGETING, TAXATION, BANKING OPTIONS, INVESTMENT OPTIONS, STOCK MARKET SIMULATION, RETIREMENT, CREDIT, RISK MANAGEMENT, AND CONSUMER PROTECTION.
  - THE COURSE WILL MEET M-F JUNE 3-JUNE 28. MONDAY, THURSDAY, & FRIDAY FROM 9:00-12:00: TUESDAY & WEDNESDAY 10-12
  - THIS CLASS IS CAPPED AT 25.

### **HEALTH FOR .50 CREDIT**

- THIS COURSE PROMOTES INDIVIDUAL WELL-BEING AND FITNESS OF STUDENTS BY EXAMINING THE ABILITY TO ACCESS. EVALUATE. AND USE BASIC HEALTH INFORMATION. SERVICES. AND PRODUCTS. THIS SUMMER HEALTH WILL BE OFFERED AS A TRADITIONAL IN-PERSON COURSE. DUE TO THE ABBREVIATED COURSE DESIGN. STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND ALL CLASSROOM DAYS AND COMPLETE THE ASSIGNMENTS BY THEIR DUE DATE IN ORDER TO EARN CREDIT.
- THIS COURSE MEETS MONDAY THURSDAY FOR 4 WEEKS (6/3 TO 6/28) FROM 9AM TO NOON

### **ONLINE ALGEBRA I FOR 1 CREDIT**

 $\alpha^2 + \beta^2 = C^2$ 

- THIS COURSE IS ALIGNED TO THE OHIO'S LEARNING STANDARDS AND IS AVAILABLE TO ANY CURRENT PRE-ALGEBRA OR ALGEBRA STUDENTS WHO WISH TO TAKE GEOMETRY THE NEXT SCHOOL YEAR.
- THE COURSE FOCUSES ON BOTH THE CONTENT STANDARDS AND MATHEMATICAL PRACTICES. THE
   CRITICAL AREAS OF FOCUS INCLUDE: UNDERSTANDING PROPERTIES OF REAL NUMBERS AND
   EXPONENTS: APPLYING AND EXTENDING UNDERSTANDING OF LINEAR, QUADRATIC, AND EXPONENTIAL
   RELATIONSHIPS IN EQUATIONS AND INEQUALITIES: USING FUNCTION MODELS TO ANALYZE DATA
   AND APPLIED SITUATIONS.
- THIS EIGHT-WEEK COURSE IS SCHEDULED FROM 5/28-7/19. THE END DATE OF 7/19 FOR THIS COURSE IS FIRM AND ALL ASSESSMENTS MUST BE COMPLETED BY THIS DATE IN ORDER TO EARN CREDIT.
- IN-PERSON MIDTERM: JUNE 21: IN-PERSON FINAL: JULY 19

### PHYSICAL EDUCATION FOR .25 CREDIT

- INTRODUCE STUDENTS TO A PHYSICALLY ACTIVE LIFESTYLE. OUR GOAL IS TO HELP OUR STUDENTS FIND SOME FORM OF PHYSICAL ACTIVITY THAT THEY CAN PARTICIPATE IN BEYOND HIGH SCHOOL. OUR HOPE IS TO DEVELOP STUDENTS THAT UNDERSTAND THE BENEFITS OF EXERCISE. AND BECOME LIFELONG PHYSICALLY ACTIVE INDIVIDUALS. TO ACHIEVE THIS GOAL, STUDENTS ARE EXPOSED TO AND PARTICIPATE IN ANAEROBIC AND AEROBIC CONDITIONING.
- STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE SEVERAL WRITINGS AND RESEARCH PAPERS ON FITNESS RELATED TOPICS. THESE WRITINGS ENCOURAGE STUDENTS TO LOOK AT PHYSICAL FITNESS DIFFERENTLY WHILE INCREASING THEIR EXPOSURE TO PHYSICAL FITNESS AND PROMOTE WRITING SKILLS.

  FAILED TO EARN CREDIT FOR ELA-9. ELA-10. ELA-11. OR ELA-12 DURING SEMESTER ONE OR SEMESTER
  TWO.
- THE INSTRUCTOR WILL MEET WITH STUDENTS IN-PERSON FOUR HOURS A WEEK FROM 6/3 6/28.

### ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT

EACH LESSON IS DESIGNED TO BE TAUGHT IN AN EXPERIENCE FIRST, FORMALIZE LATER (EFFL) APPROACH, IN WHICH STUDENTS WORK IN SMALL GROUPS ON AN ENGAGING ACTIVITY BEFORE THE TEACHER FORMALIZES THE LEARNING.

#### **ALGEBRA EXPLORATION**

- STUDENTS WILL BUILD DEEP CONCEPTUAL UNDERSTANDING AROUND THE TOPICS OF EQUIVALENCE, SOLVING EQUATIONS. AND THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN LINEAR, QUADRATIC, AND EXPONENTIAL FUNCTIONS. AN EMPHASIS IS PLACED ON DESCRIBING HOW THESE FUNCTIONS CHANGE.
- THIS COURSE WAS CREATED USING THE COMMON CORE STATE STANDARDS AS A GUIDE.
- THIS CLASS WILL BE HELD 6/3-6/7 FROM 9-10:30 AM

### GEOMETRY EXPLORATION
