



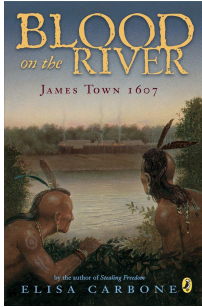
5th Grade Suggested School Supply List

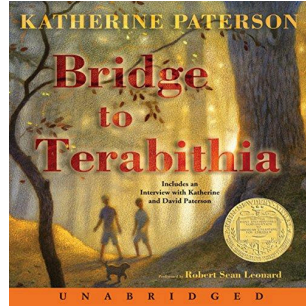

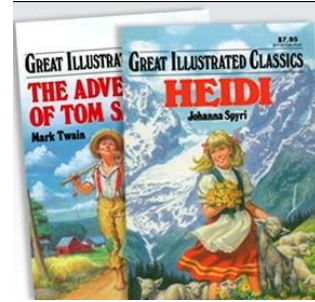
