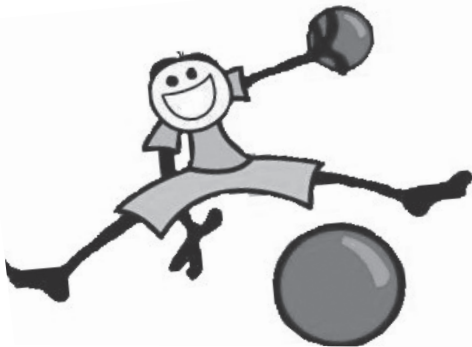
Dear Parents and Teachers,
