

## **Mt. Nittany Middle School Library Information for Homeschoolers in the State College Area School District**

Homeschoolers are welcome to use the Mt. Nittany Middle School Library. Below are guidelines for use of the library by homeschoolers and their families.

### **1. Number of books permitted to be checked out**

There is not a set number, but we recommend taking only what can be read in the two week loan period. Other limits may apply due to current research needs in the school.

### **2. May parents of homeschoolers borrow books?**

Yes, parents may sign out books that are available to the student population. Parents are to follow the same guidelines as their students in the quantity of books they may borrow.

### **3. Reserving or holding materials for home-schooled children.**

Materials may reserved following the same guidelines used for MNMS students.

### **4. Scheduling library time for homeschoolers and their families.**
