At South Shore School District, we pride ourselves on fostering success for every student and exceeding expectations on the state report card. This achievement is a testament to the hard work of our students, the dedication of our educators, and the unwavering support of our community.

Together, we are all Cardinals, and together, we soar.

Our current school building has served our community well for nearly 50 years. As we plan forward to invest in its future, we sought input from our staff, students, and community in multiple ways. All of this feedback helped shape a plan to address the biggest needs: failing building systems, safety concerns, and outdated and undersized learning spaces.

We remain committed to creating a facilities solution that reflects the priorities of taxpayers and meets the needs of our students and staff.

To gather feedback on the District's proposed long-range facilities plan, a community-wide survey was mailed to all District residents. THE RESULTS ARE IN.

Survey Results: Overall

The District hired School Perceptions, LLC., an independent Wisconsin-based firm with extensive expertise in conducting school district surveys to collect feedback.

There were 306 total respondents which represents a 25.6% response rate (15-17% is typical). Following are the questions and results.

Next Steps

The Facilities Focus Group and the Board will analyze the survey priorities and funding support to determine the next steps. Our goal is to finalize the proposed improvements and allow residents to vote in November 2024.

What We Learned...

- The majority of all respondents support the District pursuing a capital referendum to address facility needs.
- Respondents **prioritize updates** in the areas of building systems, ADA accessibility, and safety and security.
- Updates to performing arts and track are not a priority at this time.
- Respondents **expressed support** for investing in the building, but reducing the \$19.5 million cost.

When asked how the District is doing in the following areas, all questions ranked in the 90th percentile.

Delivering a high-quality education 91st percentile

Keeping the public informed 91st percentile

Managing funds appropriately 93rd percentile

Building pride in the community 99th percentile
