



OPTIONAL: Parent Right to Know Teacher Qualifications

Dear Parent/Guardian:

This letter is meant to inform you that your child's elementary school receives federal Title 1 funding; as such, you have the right to know the teaching qualifications of your child's teacher.

Federal law, the Every Student Succeeds Act, requires that any local school district receiving federal funding through Title 1 (Improving the Academic Achievement of the Disadvantaged) must notify parents of students attending a Title 1 school that they may request information regarding the professional qualifications of their student's teacher. This may include the following:

1. Whether the teacher has met the Ohio teacher licensing criteria for the grade level and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
2. Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived; and
3. Whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher;
4. Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.
