## Teacher of the Month

**Purpose:** to highlight dedicated, effective teachers in our system.

**Eligible Employees:** Certified employees

**Criteria:** To be considered certified staff:

- Must have worked in the county school system at least three (3) years.
- Must not be a “Teacher of the Month” from the preceding school year.

**Selection Process:** Members of the certified staff in the school/program will select the representative.

**Award Schedule:** Monthly, according to the following rotation:

Month	School/Program
September & January	WHS, SES
October & February	WMS, MES
November & March	CES, RMS
December & April	RES & PRE-K/District ESE - Student Services Professionals/Reading Coaches/WI Teachers

### **Award:**

- Employees’ names and month of selection will be permanently displayed on a master plaque at the district office.
- Teachers selected for this award will receive an individual plaque of commendation at a school board meeting.
- Employees’ pictures and/or an article highlighting the teacher will be submitted to the local newspaper.

## Teacher of the Year Program Guidelines

### **I. PROGRAM PURPOSE, ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION CRITERIA**

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this program is to select and recognize outstanding teachers, one of whom will represent Wakulla County Schools in the Florida Teacher of the Year Program.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- Completed three (3) consecutive years as a professional educator in Wakulla County
- Full-time certificated personnel employed as classroom teachers (PreK-Adult)
- School Counselors
- Associate Dean for Student Services
- Media Specialists
- Certified professionals who serve only one school full-time (Academic Coaches, SLP, OT, PT, etc.) are included in that school's eligible list.
- Certified Professionals who serve more than one school will be in the District Professionals group and not voted on by schools.
- Can have been School Level Teacher of the Year any previous year
- Cannot have been District Teacher of the Year the previous year only
- Not eligible: Lively, TCC or ROTC instructors

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA:**

**Professional Preparation** - Professional preparation and education, with evidence of continued professional contributions and improvement, such as courses beyond a Bachelor's Degree, in-service training, additional degrees, summer study, travel related to subject area and the like. Candidates will be asked to list all degrees and other pertinent information.

**Leadership** - Leadership in school activities, membership in school, district or state committees or professional organizations, chairmanships held, in-service conducted, formal presentations, etc.

**Superior Teaching** - A record of superior teaching as evidenced by student performance, honors, awards or other kinds of recognition, and annual performance assessments.

**Interpersonal Skills** - Demonstrates exemplary interpersonal skills in communicating with students, parents, and the community and in collaboration with other professionals.

**Caring and Respect** - Strong commitment to creating a climate of caring and respect conducive to effective teaching and learning.

## **II. SCHOOL LEVEL TEACHER OF THE YEAR**

**SELECTION PROCESS:** School Level Teachers of the Year will be selected in December of each school year according to the following guidelines:

- Members of the instructional staff of each school/program will nominate candidates by submitting their names to the appropriate administrator by a designated date
- The school administrator will distribute application forms to these nominees.
- Each nominee who submits a completed application does so with the understanding that if selected as their school's Teacher of the Year, he/she must represent the school in the district competition.
- Completed forms will be copied and distributed to all faculty members for careful consideration before a vote is taken.
- Voting will take place during a faculty meeting or in a secured location on ballots provided.
- A run-off vote will be taken on the three teachers with the most votes if there are more than five teachers nominated.
- If no more than five teachers are nominated, there will be only one vote.
- The teacher with the most votes during the second phase (if needed) becomes the School Level Teacher of the Year. In the case of a tie, a run-off vote will be taken.

## **III. DISTRICT TEACHER OF THE YEAR**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Candidates for the District Teacher of the Year are the School Level Teachers of the Year. Each school within the district will have one representative except the PreK, Adult Ed, Wakulla Institute, and District Professionals which will share a representative. There will be a total of eight candidates.

**SELECTION PROCESS:** During November/December each School Level Teacher of the Year will complete and submit an application and will be interviewed by a panel of judges. Completed applications will be read and scored by judges from outside the district who will also conduct the interviews. During the interview, each candidate will be asked to respond to the same list of questions. The scores of all judges from the application and the interview will be combined and the teacher with the highest score will be the District Teacher of the Year.

## **IV. AWARDS AND RECOGNITIONS**

Employees selected for these awards will receive individual plaques of commendation and monetary awards from the school, district and/or state. Guidelines which ensure commonality in recognizing School Level Teachers of the Year will be followed.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR WEC, MES PRE-K AND OTHER DISTRICT PROFESSIONALS

Responsible for getting information to their full-time certified personnel:

- Sunny Chancy/Belinda McElroy-District ESE/Student Services Professionals, Reading Coaches who serve more than one school

In order to let all eligible professionals who, work directly with children be nominated, the following rotation will ensue:

**2021-2022 – WEC and MES PRE-K eligible professionals.**

**2022-2023 - All full-time certified professionals at the District Office who serve more than one school (Reading Coaches, SLPs, OTs, PTs, etc.) and Wakulla Institute/Adult Education.** Sunny Chancy will coordinate and send a list of eligible candidates to the above responsible parties.

Supervisors at each site are to follow the timeline in the packet and all full-time teachers/professionals at each site are allowed to nominate and vote every year. Principals/Director of WEC/District please take nominations and votes for 2022-2023 from the full-time certified professionals. They must:

- Have completed three (3) years as a professional educator/professional in Wakulla County
- Be a full-time certified teacher/professional
- Can have been School Level Teacher of the Year any previous year

## Employee of the Month

**Purpose:** To highlight dedicated and effective educational support personnel in our system

**Eligible Employee:** Classified employee

**Criteria:** The Employee of the Month Award is presented to an employee who:

- Has worked in the district for at least two (2) consecutive years
- Goes beyond the call of duty in performing his/her job
- Has exemplary or outstanding job performance
- Loyal and dedicated to the system
- Exhibits heroism on the job
- Voluntarily takes part in activities that improve or advance student welfare

**Selection Process:** These individuals will be selected by school and district level administrators at the monthly staff meeting preceding the award.

**Award Schedule:** Monthly. At least one employee from each group listed below shall be recognized according to the following rotation

January	Facilities
December & May	School Secretaries ( All categories/titles)
June	IT
October	District/ Transportation Secretaries ( All categories/titles)
March	Food Service
November& April	Transportation ( Bus Drivers/ Van/ Mechanics)
September& February	Paraprofessionals, CDA's ( All Schools)

**Award:** Commendation. Employees selected for this award will receive an individual plaque of commendation and have their name and month of selection displayed on a permanent plaque at the district office. An article highlighting the employees' contributions and work ethic will be submitted to the local newspaper and the district website.



## Employee of the Year

**Purpose:** To determine an overall outstanding classified employee from the group of “*Employees of the Month*” and to identify a classified employee to nominate for the state school related employee of the Year award during the next school year.

**Eligible Employee:** Those selected as Employee of the Month in the current school year.

### **Criteria:**

- **Attendance:** Evidence of good and regular attendance as determined by a yearly review of leave forms
- **Performance Appraisal:** The employee must -
  - Be rated at the “Exemplary” or higher level on the district performance appraisal
  - Be recommended for rehire
  - Received no written reprimands in the current year.
- **Assessment:** Candidates will be rated by five (5) individuals from at least three (3) of the following categories: colleagues, teachers, parents, students, and community people with whom the individual comes in contact in performing their job.
  - The following areas will be assessed:
  - Job performance
  - Cooperation
  - Appearance
  - Attitude
  - Human relations skills
- **Recommendation:** A letter recommending the employee will be submitted by the candidate’s supervisor.

**Selection Process:** In October, individuals selected as an Employee of the Month during the current year shall be mailed a packet which will include instructions, assessment forms and a personnel history form. An Employee of the Year shall be selected after a review of the program criteria.

**Award Schedule:** Annually, in November

**Award:** Commendation and monetary (if available.) The employee selected for this award will receive an individual plaque of commendation and monetary award.



## **Nutrition Employee & Manager Award Criteria's**

### **Nutrition Employee of the Month Award Criteria**

- Come to work on time/daily
- Go above and beyond assigned task
- Help others within and outside the serving lines
- Great spirit and attitude
- Enjoy and/or show gratitude about their job
- Nominated by cafeteria manager
- Winner receives a \$25.00 gift card

### **Nutrition Manager of the Quarter Award Criteria**

- Come to work on time/daily
- Present a respectful attitude within kitchen/leadership
- Go above and beyond the manager duties
- Complete all required daily/monthly task on time
- Help/Assist students within and outside the serving lines
- Show great spirit for their school and his/her peers
- Enjoy and/or show gratitude towards job and kitchen staff
- Picked by the Operations Manager, approved by GM
- Winner receives a \$100.00 gift card

## Custodial Magic Carpet Award

### Primary and Secondary

**Michael.Barwick@wcsb.us**

**Purpose:** To stress the importance of attention to detail in having safe, clean, and attractive grounds and facilities.

**Eligible Employee:** The custodial staff at each school.

**Criteria:** Points will be awarded on the basis of:

- Lighting maintenance
- Yard and exterior appearance
- Cleanliness
- Attendance

Safety – Comprehensive Safety Report/Workmen’s Compensation Injury Frequency

**Selection Process:**

- Selection will be based upon an equal weighting of the above criterion.
- Evaluated by a committee of the WELA leadership group
- Committee members shall not evaluate their own school. Four to five shall be taken from district records.

**Award Schedule:** Annually, at the end of the school year.

**Award:** Commendation and monetary. A revolving plaque and \$300.00 annual allocation are presented to the winning custodial staff. The monetary award is used to purchase equipment and supplies for use in the custodial operation.

## Annual Administrative Awards School Level Annual Administrative Award

**Purpose:** To honor, recognize, and promote school level administrators and team spirit.

**Eligible Employees:** School Level Administrators

**Eligibility Process:** The elementary administrators (principal/assistant principal) with the highest school grade, the middle school administrators (principal/assistant principal) with the highest school grade, the administrators (principal/assistant principal) with the highest school grade, and the pre-k administrators (principal/assistant principal) with the highest student growth will be eligible for the selection process.

**Selection Process:** All eligible administrators (one from each level) will be placed on a ballot. All school and district administrators will vote from the four administrators on the ballot. The selection of the school level administrator of the year should be based on the following: Other qualities to consider are:

- Dedication and commitment to the Wakulla County School District
- On-task and on the job
- Responsiveness and sensitivity to other administrators, educators, staff, and the community
- Willingness to cooperate and work for consensus
- Willingness to articulate and problem solve as a team effort
- Adherence to district goals, initiatives, practices, and policies
- Leadership skills evidenced at school sites
- Commitment school's students, parents, faculty, and staff (custodians, bus drivers, paraprofessionals, cafeteria employees, secretaries, teachers)

**Award Schedule:**

- Informally at the Summer Administrative Workshop if scores are available and formally at the August Board meeting
- Commendation and clock plaque for each administrator. The school's name with administrators will be displayed on a perpetual plaque in the Superintendent's office.

## District Level Administrator of the Year

**Purpose:** To honor and recognize the efforts of district level administrators

**Eligible Employees:** District Level Administrators

**Criteria:** Appointment to and service in an administrative position during the current fiscal year. Recipients are not qualified to win the award within a three (3) year cycle.

**Other qualities to consider are:**

Dedication and commitment to the Wakulla County School District

On-task and on the job

Responsiveness and sensitivity to other administrators, educators, staff, and the community

Willingness to cooperate and work for consensus

Willingness to articulate and problem solve as a team effort

Adherence to district goals, initiatives, practices, and policies

**Selection Process:** A ballot listing all district level administrators will be sent to all school and district administrators. Ballots will be returned to designated HR staff. Ballots will be collected and secured. At the designated deadline, the ballots will be counted by designated HR staff. The results will be shared directly with the Superintendent.

**Award Schedule:** Will be aligned with School Level Administrative Award

**Award:** Commendation, clock plaque and monetary award, if available. The recipient will receive a plaque from the School Board noting the award granted. His/her name will also be placed on a perpetual plaque displayed in the Superintendent's office.
