Dear Croton-Harmon Students, Parents, Staff and Community,

On May 15th and 16th, 2024, the Croton-Harmon School District conducted water testing from potentially used drinking sources using an outside professional environmental consultant, WSP USA, INC. These results were shared and reviewed by the Health and Safety Committee on June 3rd, 2024.

Public Health Law and New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) regulations require that all public schools test lead levels in water from every outlet that is being used or could potentially be used, for drinking or cooking. Of all locations tested at CET, there were no sources that exceeded the NYS action level of 5 ppb. Of all the locations sampled at PVC, there were two sources found that exceeded the NYS action level of 5 ppb. Of all the locations tested at CHHS, there were two sample locations tested that exceeded the 5 ppb. The sources that exceeded 5 ppb were removed from service or had NYS required signage added. At this time, no drinking sources currently in use at CET, PVC or CHHS exceed the NYS action level.
