 - a) We do not know if we've received the CSI grant yet or, if we have, how much we will receive
 - b) Does this council approve the use of the grant money to fund a full-time counselor?
 - (1) Has been funded through grant funding for the last 4 years

- F. SPSA Goal 2.1- Parent Engagement
1. This funding is based on enrollment
 2. It is for meeting supplies: books, handouts, incentives

- G. SPSA Goal 2.2- Student engagement
