Eastern Suffolk BOCES is excited to offer engaging Summer Enrichment Programs for students entering grades 1-9 during July and August. Take advantage of an opportunity to give your students the benefit of a summer enrichment program in your district run by Eastern Suffolk BOCES under the supervision of an ESBOCES appointed director and staff.

These programs aim to provide a stimulating and fun learning experience during the summer break. They can include a wide range of exciting and enriching opportunities designed to nurture intellectual curiosity, creativity and personal growth including field trips, swimming, literacy, STEAM-based (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics) activities, Arts-in-Education experiences and presentations and a SEL (Social and Emotional Learning) curriculum. Programs are customizable to meet your district's needs and may also include additional supports such as guided reading, the Science of Reading literacy instruction, Orton-Gillingham reading support, or support for your ELL populations.

# **Frequently Asked Questions:**

 How long is the program? There are typically three 2 week sessions during July and August, and all registrants must enroll by the session.

Are breakfast and lunch provided?
 Typically, parents provide all lunch and snacks for their children, however, districts may choose to provide meals.

- Is transportation provided?
  Parents provide transportation to and from the program.
- Are students allowed to bring electronic devices to the program?

A device-free policy is implemented. Students are not allowed to bring in their personal mobile or electronic gaming devices.

# Sample Program Activities English Language Learner (ELL) Support

Students identified by the district as English Language Learners (ELLs) will receive additional supports through a push-in model. In this model, an ENL teacher supports ELL students during content instruction in collaboration with enrichment teachers to provide language acquisition and vocabulary support. The ENL teacher co-plans and co-teaches with our enrichment teachers to provide targeted English language development within the provided curriculum.

### **STEAM Activities**

Hands-on STEAM activities are designed to make ALL students get excited about the world around them. Sample programs may include: Drones, Oceanic Exploration, Claymation, Makey Makey, Green Screen, Genetics, Famous Architecture Around the World, Plants and Seeds and Unleash Your Wild Side.

### **Literacy Courses**

Students will participate in small groups specifically designed to develop literacy skills and engage students in their learning. Students should have fun as they design and author their own creative works.

#### Additional course options may include:

Cooking Up Even More Stories, Enchanted STEAM Fairy Tales, Mock Trial, Candy Making, Observing Ozobots, Ornithology, and Viva Italiano.

#### **Reading Adventures - Reading for All**

Students will explore a wide variety of texts by participating in small reading groups at their instructional levels and will become involved in activities related to their reading. Reading Adventures will use fiction and non-fiction to engage students as they learn how reading can expand their world.

## **Field Trips**

Field trips are offered to all students, and the cost is included in the tuition. A parent or guardian may opt their child out of any scheduled field trip.

#### Swimming

Students (with parent/guardian permission) will be bused one day a week to the town pool. Students not going will join the regular afternoon schedule.

#### **Other Special Events**

Students registered for our last session are invited to join the end-of-summer carnival/picnic.
