### **Weed High School**

The original high school, located at School house Hill, consisted of two classrooms, two restrooms, an office, one faculty member and nine or ten students. It was a two year branch high school until 1919 when it became a four year school. For over forty years (with additional classrooms and additions) this school served the needs of the community. The plant is now being used as the City Hall for Weed. In 1959, a new high school, the current one, was built on a larger tract of land only a short distance from the original school.
