Instructions:

1. Go to this website: gbnz.io/GTYCA2AF
2. Type in this invite code: **JAGUAR-GTYCA2AF**

note: Use your DCDS login credentials!

3. Scroll down to the **BIBLIOTECA**. Click on a story and complete the reading and activities. **REPEAT** for all stories.

4. Getting used to the format and what to expect may require some patience on your end. I have adjusted the settings so that you may do a story as many times as you like. I will take the best score listed on the first day of school.

5. Again, these stories are due **THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL**.
