Mike Swan moved to hire Joel Rogers as High School Principal for the 2018-19 school year. The motion was seconded by Kelly Duncan. Additional discussion then continued about the top two candidates, Joel Rogers and Jason Slater. After this additional discussion, Mike Swan withdrew his motion and Kelly Duncan withdrew her second.

Dennis Grue moved to hire Jason Slater as High School Principal for the 2018-19 school year. The motion was seconded by Brand Robinson and it carried with a unanimous vote 6-0.
