PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Thank you for welcoming the School-Based Health Center into your community. We are wrapping up our third year of operations and looking forward to bringing you even more health care services next school year. We couldn't have done all this work without our wonderful team of local health care providers and our amazing school partners.

- **The EYE See Clinic** provided eye exams to 41 students and provided 25 glasses and 4 updated prescriptions for glasses this year.
- **The Olympic Valley Clinic** provided medical services to 58 students this year.
- True North provided prevention and early intervention services to 10 students this year.
- Elma Family Dental provided 89 oral health screenings to 59 students this year.
- **Big Smiles Dental** provided 41 dental appointments including exams, cleanings, sealants, fillings and fluoride.
- **The Elma SBHC** provided health education to 280 students.
