<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sits quietly for 10-15 minutes</li> <li>• Understand causes and effects</li> <li>• Begin to share with others</li> <li>• Starts to follow rules</li> <li>• Able to recognize authority</li> <li>• Begin to control oneself</li> <li>• Separates from parents</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Says his/her first and last name</li> <li>• Manage bathroom needs</li> <li>• Can feed themselves</li> <li>• Buttons, zips</li> <li>• Able to get ready to go without parental help</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recognizing and naming colors</li> <li>• Pay attention to adult-directed tasks</li> <li>• Speak understandably</li> <li>• Talk in complete sentences of five to six words</li> <li>• Listen to stories without interrupting</li> <li>• Look at pictures and then tell stories</li> <li>• Recognize rhyming sounds</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Writes scribbles, letters/numbers</li> <li>• Recognizes letters of the alphabet</li> <li>• Says the alphabet</li> <li>• Identify rhyming words</li> <li>• Identify the beginning sound of some words</li> <li>• Identify some alphabet letters</li> <li>• Recognize some sight words like "stop"</li> </ul>
