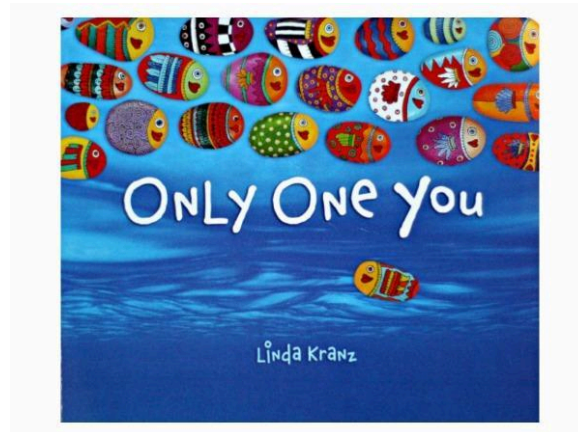




Kindergarten Summer Reading
