#### **WORLD FOOD SAFETY DAY**

World Food Safety Day, celebrated every June 7: It is more than just a date on the calendar; it represents a global commitment to ensuring that the food we consume is safe and nutritious. It's a day that underscores the importance of collective efforts in maintaining the safety of our food supply chain, from farm to table.

#### NEED A PHYSICAL FOR SCHOOL OR CAMP?

Contact your child's school nurse if you are having financial difficulties affording a school or camp physical. We have a partnership with Convenient MD for physical vouchers. This is not available for sick visits.

#### **Grade 6 Students**

A physical exam dated 8/1/23 or later and the Tdap vaccine is due prior to starting 7th Grade at HBMS. Please send this information to Maureen Lorden, RN, CSDA prior to June 13, 2023.

#### Seasonal Allergies -Keeping Symptoms in Check

Symptoms include: congestion-sneezing-itchy eyes- stuffy nose-fatigue-cough-sore throat due to post nasal drip. Discuss a treatment plan with your child's doctor for the best relief/treatment options. If your child is experiencing symptoms, please administer medication at home. We <u>DO NOT</u> have over the counter oral allergy medication or allergy eye medication at school. If your child may need additional medication during the school day, contact the nurse for the forms needed to provide other medication to administer at school. After being outside, remind your child to wash their hands and face to remove surface pollen.



#### WHAT IS HAPPENING IN THE HEALTH OFFICES:

We are continuing to see conjunctivitis (pink eye), strep throat, allergies, and ticks/bug bites. If they are diagnosed with conjunctivitis or strep throat, please start treatment as soon as possible and provide a return to school note for the nurse.
