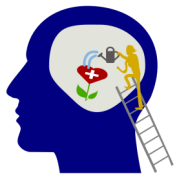

### NEED A PHYSICAL FOR SCHOOL OR CAMP?

Contact your child's school nurse if you are having financial difficulties affording a school or camp physical. We have a partnership with Convenient MD for physical vouchers. This is not available for sick visits.

### Seasonal Allergies - Keeping Symptoms in Check



**Symptoms include:** congestion- sneezing-itchy eyes- stuffy nose-fatigue-cough- sore throat due to post nasal drip. **Discuss a treatment plan with your child's doctor for the best relief/treatment options.** If your child is experiencing symptoms, please administer medication at home. We **DO NOT** have over the counter oral allergy medication or allergy eye medication at school. If your child may need additional medication during the school day, contact the nurse for the forms needed to provide other medication to administer at school. After being outside, remind your child to wash their hands and face to remove surface pollen.



### WHAT IS HAPPENING IN THE HEALTH OFFICES:

We are continuing to see conjunctivitis (pink eye), strep throat, allergies, and ticks/bug bites. If they are diagnosed with conjunctivitis or strep throat, please start treatment as soon as possible and provide a return to school note for the nurse.
