



Title: STEM Teacher for Grades 1-8

The Grosse Pointe Academy seeks a full-time STEM teacher for students in grades 1-8. The candidate should have previous STEM teaching experience and a Michigan teaching certification. While this position encompasses many different duties, its primary function is to plan, organize, and implement an engaging instructional program in a learning environment that guides and encourages students to develop and fulfill their academic and creative potential.

Candidates should demonstrate flexibility, energy, enthusiasm, high expectations of themselves and their students, and an understanding of students' developmental needs.

Reports to: Assistant Head of School for Curriculum and Student Performance

Responsibilities: This teacher will be responsible for working with the Assistant Head of School for Curriculum and Student Performance to lead the implementation of Science, Technology, Engineering and Math for grades 1-8. They will guide the development of inquiry and problem based projects and experiments conducted in our Innovation and Design Lab.

Duties Include:

- Implement STEM-oriented learning activities to be conducted in the Innovation and Design Lab for grades 1-4 and Middle School electives
- Employ a variety of instructional techniques, instructional media, and performance assessments, which guide the learning process toward curriculum goals and student learning
- Use technology to promote learning, creativity, and collaboration
- Work directly with school administrators and staff in the development, implementation and evaluation of STEM initiatives and curriculum
- Organize, develop and coordinate special STEM events/activities
- Report monthly to the Assistant Head of School for Curriculum and Student Performance
- Attend professional development and training related to STEM programs and methodologies, staying abreast of current research
- Perform other duties TBD by the Head of School/Assistant Head of School for Curriculum and Student Performance
- Follow all school policies and procedures as stated in the Employee Handbook.

Coaching and extracurricular opportunities are also available if interested.

Qualifications:

- Degree in Education, Education Administration, or a related field.
- Minimum of five years of experience working directly with students.

The successful candidate must provide a mandated fingerprint clearance.
