ATTIRE

It is a luau theme! Students should dress comfortably, and we suggest bright colors. We also recommend comfortable, safe shoes. Students should not wear hats or glasses, as we want to see their beautiful faces. Leave backpacks and cell phones with parents. Students will not need them, and they will be a distraction.

ARRIVAL

9:00 a.m. Celebrations: (Team Rocco and Team DeLucia) Students can arrive at 7:45 a.m. If parents choose to drive their children later, they must come to school by 8:30 a.m.

11:00 a.m. Celebrations: (Team Morello and Team Domurad) Students can arrive at 7:45 a.m. If parents choose to drive their children later, they must come to school by **10:15 a.m.**

GUESTS

Each student can bring up to five guests due to seating in the auditorium. Members of the HMS team will be present to check families into the celebration. Please enter the school together as a family.

PARKING

Guests will be able to park their vehicles on the side lot. We recommend that families drive together to the celebration to reduce the number of vehicles. Listen to the directions of our staff and the CERT Team; they are ready to help!

DISMISSAL

We understand most parents will dismiss their child after the celebration. We want to make the process efficient for all. Parents who plan to bring their child home after the celebration MUST complete this form. <u>https://forms.gle/xA3nvk5KYZurNVwy9</u> The celebration is about 60 minutes. At the conclusion of the celebration, families must depart as soon as possible. As a reminder, other families will be arriving for the next celebration at 10:30 a.m. <u>Note: Only 53 families completed this sign out form. Based on past years, most families want to take their HMS Dragons home after the celebration. In order to avoid long "sign out" lines, please complete this form.</u>

PHOTOGRAPHER

We hired a photographer from LifeTouch to photograph students when their name is called. While it will be tempting to run up and take a picture, we ask parents to stay in their seats. We will share the link in an upcoming Dragon's Tale. Parents can view and purchase selected pictures.

Library Book Returns


You will receive an email letting you know what library materials your child currently has checked out. All library materials must be returned to school as soon as possible. We appreciate your help with locating and returning our library books!
