Agenda Items and Discussion:

1. Review of New Stipend Request - FHS Testing Coordinator

Principal Gulko attended the meeting and explained the rationale for the need for the FHS Testing Coordinator stipend position. The amount and complexity of standardized testing has increased. As a result, the time necessary to plan and manage the testing has increased significantly.

Principal Gulko clarified that in addition to after hour responsibilities, some of the tasks required to coordinate the testing must occur during the school day. This requires this staff member complete their regular responsibilities outside of the school day.

The committee unanimously approved the FHS Testing Coordinator stipend at the 10 point range.

The stipend will need to be approved by the Board of Directors at their June 12, 2024 meeting. In addition, the FY25 budget will need to pass.
