## **Medication Pick Up**

If your student has any medications in the health room, please remember that all medications must be picked up by a parent/guardian at the end of the last day of school - Friday, June 21st.

- Emergency medications will not be released until AFTER the end of the last day of school – you may pick up Friday, June 21st, between 11:50pm and 1:50pm
- Self-Carry: Students who are approved as both self-carry and health room storage, may sign out their emergency medications from the health room, unless requested otherwise by parent/guardian.
- Non-Emergency medications may be picked up by the parent/guardian any time prior to the last day of school.

## **SBA Scores in Family Access**

Scores (level and scale score) for this spring's SBA ELA and math assessments will be added to Skyward Family Access on June 21. Full page PDF reports from OSPI with more scoring details will be available in the fall and these will be posted to Family Access at that time.

Only SBA ELA and math scores will be available in June. Science scores will not be available until the fall after OSPI releases those scores. Information for families about the test score timeline will be included in the first June issue of Connections.
