INSTRUMENT CARE REMINDERS

Care of instrument

- 1. Handle the instrument with care.
- 2. Keep the instrument clean. Use a soft, dry cloth to remove dirt and rosin.
- 3. Store the instrument in its case when it is not being used.
- 4. Remove the shoulder pad before storing the instrument in the case.
- 5. Always check the latches on the case to be sure that they are secure.
- 6. Store books or music outside of the instrument case.
- 7. Keep the instrument away from extreme heat or cold (ex. leaving the instrument in the car can SEVERELY damage the instrument).
- 8. Repairs are to be done by Mrs. Schrade or a trained repair person ONLY.
- 9. Keep the instrument out of reach of small children.

Care of Bow

- 1. Bows break easily. Be careful not to hit them on other objects.
- 2. Oils from your skin will damage the bow hair. Keep the bow hair away from skin.
- 3. Tighten and rosin the bow before use.
- 4. Loosen the bow and wipe the bow stick with a soft, dry cloth after use.
- 5. Store the bow inside the case when it is not being used.
