<p><b>A</b></p> <p>Restate Question Ideas</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Change the question to a statement (Restate) and answer OR make a <b>Claim</b> using keywords from the question.</li><li>2. Write your statement and give the answer in your own words, being sure to completely answer the question.</li><li>3. Re-read, knowing you will be supporting <b><u>your answer</u></b> with evidence.</li></ol>
<p><b>C</b></p> <p>Cite Evidence Frames</p>	<p>Based on <b><u>your answer</u></b>, provide text based evidence and/or background knowledge to support your claim. Include 2 details!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● In the text is said....</li><li>● According to .....</li><li>● In the document...</li><li>● This person said, "... " .....</li><li>● One case showed that .....</li><li>● For instance in the .....</li><li>● To demonstrate....</li></ul> <p>You will want to either summarize what the source said or quote a specific portion, not everything.</p>
