The Transition School to Work (TSW) program, in partnership with Vocational Rehabilitation (VR), assists students with disabilities in the transition process from school into competitive employment and/or post-secondary training and education.

A variety of services will be offered to guide the students toward becoming competitively employed and/or enrolled in a post-secondary or vocational program following their exit from high school.

Students may receive the following, but not limited to: job placement and/or training services, job related instruction, independent living skills training, and assistance with transition planning.

All services are based on individual need regarding post-secondary goal.

The Transition School to Work program is a collective team effort including:

- TSW Transition Technician
- Vocational Rehabilitation
 Counselor
- Parent/Legal Guardian
- Community Partners
- Other

Responsibilities of Students

- Must be eligible for Vocational Rehabilitation Services*
- Must be an active Transition School to Work program participant
- Enroll in Career Inquiry and Career Development (TSW classes) to receive all the benefits of the program

*Students qualify for vocational rehabilitation services when they have a documented disability that is a barrier to employment.

Responsibilities of School

- · Recruiting students
- Assessing students with the VR Counselor
- Developing community relations and supports
- Monitoring students on the job
- Providing employability skills through the Transition School to Work program classes and consultations
- Facilitating career exploration and transition planning
- Provide work experience and job shadow opportunities

Responsibilities of VR Counselor

- Providing career counseling
- Establishing student eligibility
- Developing Individual Plans for Employment
- Providing additional support services
- Continuing services after graduation

This program is dedicated to helping students make a seamless transition from high school to adult life. Our goal is to prepare the students for the competitive work place and/or postsecondary education. Students who participate in the Transition School to Work program will obtain the transition skills needed for success.
