

# Kindergarten Summer Literacy Activities

## What are essential beginning literacy skills?

Letter Naming -The ability to quickly recognize and name uppercase and lower case letters

Phonological Awareness - The ability to manipulate the sounds of spoken words

Phonics - Knowing all the sounds of the letters of the alphabet

<u>Decoding</u> - The ability to read new words by sounding them out and blending them back together to form real words

### **Literacy Activities**

### **Letter Naming**

- Practice with flash cards.
- Match up upper case and lower case letters.

#### **Phonological Awareness**

- Play rhyming games. Say two words that rhyme (e.g. bat, hat) and ask your child to say a word that rhymes with your words.
- Take turns thinking of two words that begin with the same sound (e.g. man, mop; duck, dog; fat, furry).
- Play the "say it fast" game. Say a word, one sound at a time and have your child say the word at a normal rate. For example, you say each sound in the word bat, "/b/ /a/ /t/." Then your child says the word at the normal speed, "bat."

#### **Phonics**

- Make a list of CVC words and have your child practice sounding them out and blending them back together to form real words. (e.g. mat, fan, bet, pen, hid, pot, cod, hut)
- Write two sets of CVC words on flash cards. Play memory!

#### **Book Reading**

- Schedule at least 20 minutes a day for reading.
- Picture Walk Before Reading, guide your child in making predictions as he/she looks at each picture.
- Talk about interesting and new words while reading.
- Model Fluent Reading Bring your energy and excitement to books as you read them aloud!
- After reading, talk about what happened at the beginning, middle and end of the story.
