

Zoom Meeting Expectations

Student Expectations

- Please have your student(s) attend the meeting by sitting in a quiet place with limited background noises
 - If student(s) are walking around or in a noisy area with their devices, it can become distracting to the class.
- Remind students that the class expectations are the same as they would be at school.
 - Teachers will have behavior expectations and consequences in place so that I (Mr. Beauvais) can run an effective meeting/class. This may include:
 - Redirecting students.
 - Shutting off a student's audio and/or video as needed.
 - Having a student visit the "waiting room" until they are ready to join the class with appropriate behavior.
- Have your child finish eating and drinking before the meeting, or have him/her wait until after the meeting.
- Be sure to have your child dress appropriately as dress code applies.
- Please have your child have charging cord plugged in and ready to use if need be.
 - Pencil and paper are optional
- During the meeting students may be muted during lessons as it helps with background noise and focus while teacher is instructing or a student is speaking.
- During the lesson portion of the meetings, it is helpful for you to put the screen on "speaker" view. This will show a large picture of the instructor, and a smaller picture of the student. For group discussions it is fun to have the screen on gallery view so the student can see the entire class.

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Classroom Safety:

- Participation in Zoom meetings will have camera on, face in frame, and audio available.
- Students Zoom names must be the student's first and last name.
- Zoom meeting links are not to be shared, posted, or used by students not enrolled in a specific class.
- When using the "Chat" and/or "Annotation" functions or contributing to classroom discussions, students will refrain from the use of profanity, slang, distracting comments/ pictures/ emojis/ venturing off topic, etc.
- Zoom meetings will be recorded. Video recordings should only be shared with students in the designated course.
 - Only the teachers face will be shown.

Parent / Guardian Expectations

- Appropriate conduct and dress that were applicable on campus for families are extended to Zoom Meetings and include the following:
 - Appropriate clothing
 - Also be fully clothed
 - Appropriate language
 - Appropriate actions including but not limited to:
 - No smoking
 - No alcohol
