Key Strategic Priority Area 1- Excellence in Student Learning: DVUSD will raise student academic achievement and social emotional learning to prepare our graduates for college and careers.

- 1. During the 2021-2022 school year, Mirage will improve K-3 reading skills as evidenced by reducing the number of intensive students from 26% to 21% or lower on DIBELS.
- 2. During the 2021-2022 school year, Mirage will improve K-3 reading skills as evidenced by reducing the gap between gen ed and SpEd from 41% to 39% or lower on DIBELS.
- 3. During the 2021-2022 school year, Mirage will improve 6th grade reading skills as evidenced by increasing the % correct from 31% to 36% or more on the DV ELA assessment.
- 4. During the 2021-2022 school year, Mirage will improve 6th grade reading skills as evidenced by reducing the gap between gen ed and SpEd from 18% to 16% or lower on the DV ELA assessment.
- 5. During the 2021-2022 school year, Mirage will improve 3rd-6th grade math skills as evidenced by increasing the % correct from 45% to 50% or more on the DV Interim Assessment.
- 6. During the 2021-2022 school year, Mirage will improve 3rd-6th grade math skills as evidenced by reducing the gap between gen ed and SpEd from 18% to 16% or lower on the DV Interim Assessment.

- 1. During the 2021-2022 school year, Mirage will increase parent and community members' participation efforts as evidenced by increasing the survey response rate on the Annual DVUSD Stakeholder Survey from 5% to at least 10% or more.
- 2. During the 2021-2022 school year, Mirage will increase the knowledge of parent and community members regarding teacher collaborative efforts on early release days, as evidenced by an increase on the Annual DVUSD Stakeholder Survey from 47% to 52% or more.
