Social Emotional Learning

SEL lessons are created based on campus survey data and feedback from teachers and students and are taught by a counselor to the Renaissance students during campus FLEX time. FLEX time is our daily 30 minute intervention & extension time.

7th grade Renaissance Students wanted to start a Rubik's Cube FLEX class and a teacher offers that one day a week for interested students. Another class is taught by two or our Renaissance students who teach students who sign up how to make Origami. FLEX time classes have helped create a sense of community on campus.
