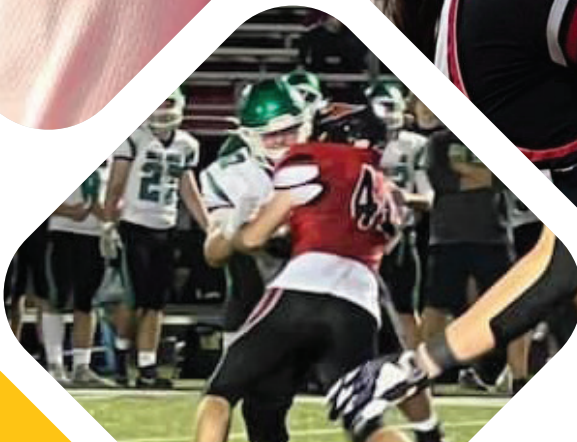
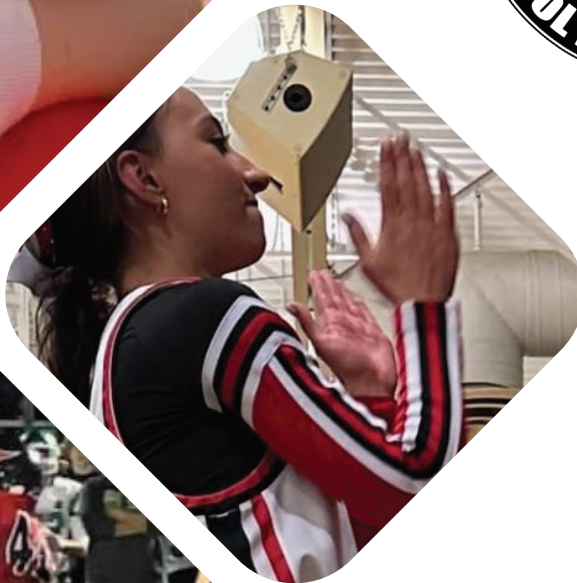

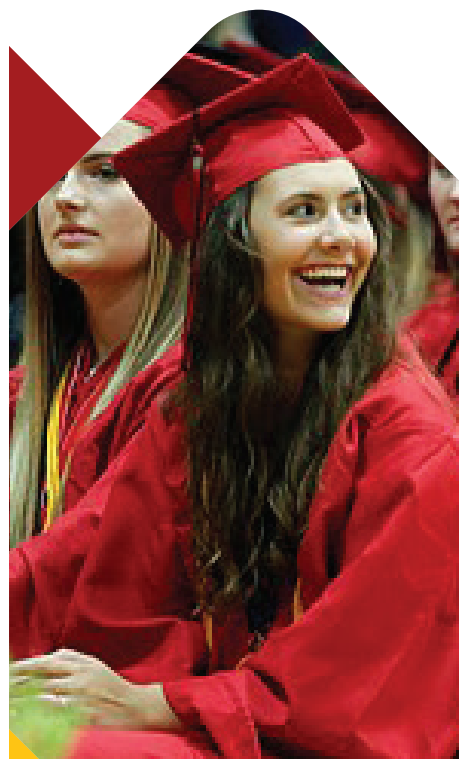

ABOUT THE DISTRICT

Located in Canfield, Ohio, the Canfield Local School District serves 2,442 students in grades K-12. Canfield Schools offer all-day kindergarten, elementary art and music, STEM education, virtual labs, gifted education, reading and math intervention, guidance and inclusion services, fourteen AP courses, college in high school, a digital academy, a highly competitive interscholastic sports program with twenty-four varsity sports, internship opportunities, a highly-acclaimed drama program, band and choir programs along with a nationally ranked speech & debate team.

Recognized as a top-performing district by the Ohio Department of Education, Canfield Local Schools achieved a 5-star overall rating on the 2023 State Report Card. Canfield High School has also achieved top-tier recognition, being ranked 47th in the state of Ohio by the prestigious US News & World Report. Approximately 97.8% of students graduate from Canfield High School in four years.

The Canfield Schools are fiscally stable, spending 70.6% on classroom instruction, and are committed to providing a well-rounded, dynamic education for our students!

Mahoning County Career and Technical Center

The Mahoning County Career and Technical Center provides a comprehensive program of vocational training. The programs offered are two years in duration, in the junior and senior years of high school. Students attend classes at the MCCTC and, in most cases, receive a vocational certificate upon successful completion of all requirements. Students may attend classes on a full-time basis or attend CHS for academic classes and the MCCTC for vocational courses.

Global Languages

We offer four levels of German, Italian and Spanish - one credit per course. German II & III are offered online for those students completing the sequence.

- » Canfield High School ranked 15th out of 880 Ohio high schools on the Performance Index.
- » Canfield High School was named to the 2023 AP School Honor Roll.
- » Canfield High School was recognized among the Best High Schools in the Nation by US News and World Report for the 2023-2024 school year.
- » 100% of our students met the Third Grade Reading Guarantee requirements for promotion to 4th grade in the 2022-23 school year.
- » The Canfield Local School District received the highest rating and received zero noncompliance findings by The Ohio Department of Education in the Special Education Annual Rating and the Special Education Profile.
- » Both Canfield High School and Canfield Village Middle School are designated as Purple Star Schools by the Ohio Department of Education for their commitment to students and families connected to our nation's military.
- » Canfield Local School District was awarded the District Recognition Award for the 2023 Ohio PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports) Showcase.

Special Services

The Canfield Local Schools Special Services Department is responsible for overseeing Special Education, Gifted Education, the Comprehensive Continuous Improvement Plan (CCIP), Academic Acceleration for Advanced Learners and Early Entrance to Kindergarten, compliance with Section 504 Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and Americans with Disabilities Act Amendments Act (ADAAA), Limited English Proficient (LEP), Federal Title 1 programs and Homelessness. We are proud to support our students through instruction tailored to individual needs.
