

PROPOSITIONS


Proposition A (\$40.2 million):

Additions and renovations to the existing AMCHS athletic field house and the existing athletic stadiums at AMCHS and CSHS for football, band, dance soccer, track and other student groups.

Proposition B (\$13.27 million):

Renovations to the existing AMCHS baseball/softball stadiums and existing CSHS baseball/softball stadiums.









