School is out, summer meals are in! Orange County Public Schools is participating in the Seamless Summer Option. Meals will be provided to all children without charge and are the same for all children regardless of race, color, national origin, sex (including gender identity and sexual orientation), disability, or age, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service.

Meals will be provided, on a first come, first serve basis, at the sites and times listed below. Children must remain onsite while consuming their meals.

- June 3-13 Monday through Thursday at Unionville Elementary School breakfast 8:00-8:15 & lunch 11:15-11:30, Gordon-Barbour Elementary School breakfast 8:15-8:30 & lunch 11:45-12:00, Orange Elementary School breakfast 8:15-8:30 & lunch 11:15-11:30, Orange County High School breakfast 8:15-8:30 & lunch 11:15-11:30, Lightfoot Elementary School breakfast 8:15-8:30 & lunch 11:45-12:00, Locust Grove Elementary School breakfast 8:15-8:30 & lunch 11:45-12:00, Locust Grove Middle School 8:30-8:45 and lunch 12:45-1:00, Prospect Heights Middle School breakfast 8:15-8:30 & lunch 11:15-11:30, and Taylor Education Administration Complex breakfast 8:45-9:00 & lunch 11:45-12:00.
- June 20-July 25 Monday through Thursday at Gordon-Barbour Elementary School, Locust Grove Elementary School, Taylor Education Administration Complex continue breakfast and lunch service at the same times as above.

Meals-to-go kits will be distributed on Thursdays and each kit will include breakfast and lunch for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Meal-to-go kits will be distributed on a first come, first serve basis, at the sites and times as follows:

- June 6 & 13 at Gordon-Barbour Elementary School 12:00-12:15, Orange Elementary School 11:30-11:45, Orange County High School 11:30-11:45, Unionville Elementary School 11:30-11:45, Lightfoot Elementary School 12:00-12:15, Prospect Heights Middle School 11:30-11:45, and Locust Grove Middle School 1:00-1:15.
- June 6 & 13 at Taylor Education Administration Complex 12:15-12:30 and Locust Grove Elementary School 4:00-4:15.
- June 20-July 25 every Thursday at Gordon-Barbour Elementary School 12:00-12:15, Taylor Education Administration Complex 12:15-12:30, and Locust Grove Elementary School 4:00-4:15.
 - Closed July 4 - meal kits will be distributed curbside on July 3.
