ELA Standards

- Where can I find the new K-12 ELA standards and crosswalk documents?

- When will the new K -12 ELA standards be implemented?
 - o Beginning of 2018-2019 school year
- When will the implementation of new K-12 ELA assessments begin?
 - ELA/Reading Grades 3-8 and High Schools: General and *NCEXTEND 1* Field Test Year 2018-2019, Initial Operational Year 2019-2020
- How will the transition to new assessments affect score reporting?
 - o Score reporting <u>will be delayed</u> in the Initial Operational Year, 2019-2020, to allow for standard setting. More information on the delay and impact will be provided by NCDPI in late summer 2018.
- What instructional resources are available from NCDPI?
 - A <u>virtual implementation kit</u> (← **hyperlink**) which includes lessons, standards, resources, text selection guide, and other resources is available.
- What parent resources are provided?
 - NCDPI provides an online page for parents that will include guides and resources for understanding the standards and supporting their students outside of the classroom.
- Will the standards be unpacked?
 - The new format includes a clarification that will replace the traditional unpacking document. The clarification will include standard explanations, examples, ideas for instruction, and a glossary.
