

2020 Staff NCO Wives' Club Scholarship

Information & Application

This scholarship is available through the arduous work of our volunteers and the proceeds of the Thrift Shop aboard Camp Lejeune. Our goal is to provide financial assistance to family members of active duty, retired or deceased service members of the United States Armed Forces.

Applicants must be attending an accredited educational or technical institution in the Fall of 2020 or Spring, Summer semesters of 2021. Students receiving full scholarships, appointments to a Service Academy or an ROTC scholarship are not considered. All funds will be sent to the college financial aid office. It is the responsibility of the recipient to notify us if there are any changes in school of choice. Failure to notify us of changes cause delays in processing your award. The following points must be adhered.

- The four part requirements and documentation must accompany the application.
- Applications must be mailed and postmarked no later than Friday, March 13th 2020.
- Applications, which do not include all parts of the application, will be disqualified.
- Recipients will be notified in writing no later than Monday, April 13th 2020.
- A current phone number and email address must be included in the application.

REQUIREMENTS

Part 1 - ELIGIBILITY

- ❖ A dependent son or daughter of an active duty, retired, or deceased member of the US Armed Forces.
- ❖ A graduating High School senior, a currently enrolled full-time college or graduate student attending an accredited college with a parent residing in Onslow County.
- ❖ A spouse of an active duty service member, retired, or deceased member of the US Armed Forces residing in Onslow County.
- ❖ Must submit proof of Onslow County (ex: copy of current utility bill).
- ❖ A VALID COPY OF APPLICANT'S MILITARY I.D. CARD MUST BE INCLUDED WITH APPLICATION.

Part 2 - SCHOLASTIC RECORD

- ❖ SAT/ACT score (if applicable)
- ❖ Official certified high school or college sealed transcripts.
- ❖ List of awards and honors.
- ❖ Two current letters of recommendation from a teacher, high school counselor or a church/civic group leader. Letters of recommendation must be dated between August 2019 and March 2020. Each letter must be an original, sealed, signed, and dated. We will not accept electronic signatures.

Part 3 – GAUGE

- ❖ Financial need.
- ❖ Total achievement and Scholastic records.
- ❖ Extenuating circumstances will be considered, please explain on a separate piece of paper.

Part 4 - NARRATIVE

- ❖ In an essay of 300 word or more, please provide an answer to all parts of the narrative question on page 3. Failure to answer all parts of the essay question will cause deduction.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The applicant must read and sign the statement below. A parent/guardian must also read and sign if the applicant is a minor or graduating High School Senior.

- ❖ I understand that I am or my son/daughter is applying for this scholarship. I have read and completed all the requirements requested to be eligible for an award.

- ❖ I will verify school of choice by Friday, May 31st 2020.
