INTRODUCTION

We're glad you're considering applying for the Nancy Cleveland Memorial Scholarship this year. The Onslow County Republican Women's Club (OCRWC) is committed to supporting future female leaders who embrace and embody the conservative values and spirit of the North Carolina Republican platform. The heart of that platform is the belief that the strength of our nation lies with the individual; and each person's dignity, freedom, ability and responsibility must be honored.

ELIGIBILITY

This scholarship is open to **female high school seniors** who:

- reside in Onslow County, NC, and are legal residents of the United States of America;
- are currently attending any Onslow County public, private, charter, or home school; and
- will be attending a university, college, or advanced technical school in the next 12 months.

The OCRWC Nancy Cleveland Memorial Scholarship funds are to be used for higher education expenses only.

THE PROCESS

Applicants must complete the application form enclosed in this document and submit a brief essay (500-800 words) on a conservative political topic that is selected each year by the OCRWC Scholarship Committee.

Submissions may be entered by email, postal mail or in person on or before April 30th.

Submitted applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and a scholarship recipient will be selected by May 15th.

ESSAY TOPIC & REQUIREMENTS

In honor of the 100th Anniversary of the 19th Amendment, this Year's Topic/Theme is:
The 19th Amendment: How Republicans Influenced the Success of the Suffrage Movement

- Essays must be:
 - submitted in English, formatted as a Word Doc or saved as PDF;
 - typed, double-spaced, in Arial 12 font;
 - composed of no less than 500 but no more than 800 words;
 - include footnotes/citations for referenced material;
 - include a cover page containing the essay's title, the student's name, contact information, high school and guidance counselor;
 - on each page, include title in the upper left corner, the student's name in the upper right corner and the page number at the bottom;
 - note the total word count at the bottom of the last page; and
 - the essay must be the original work of the student applying.
- Save a copy of your work. No entries will be returned to applicants.
