

State College Field Hockey Boosters Meeting 9/3/20 8:30pm

Sharon Herlocher points of emphasis:

- Interim plan is very different than the summer plan. A lot of different rules and regulations to review and implement
- They(athletic department) want us to play regional only.
- May try and do some Saturday double headers over the course of competition schedule.
- All players will need to complete a new waiver/acknowledgement with the implementation of the new interim return to play plan approved by the School Board.
- Fans are permitted per Governor Wolf's updated recommendation following crowd sizes for indoor and outdoor spectators, social distancing, and face coverings.
- Everything is on the table. Governor Wolf.
- Not sure if we can move forward with the player inter-squad 7v7 at this time.

- Will be sending out an email to players on Friday, September 4 to discuss updates and updated requirements with the interim return to play guidelines approved by the school board on 9/2/20
- Player evaluations/cuts will not be at least for another week
 - Currently optional practices are averaging 30-35 players
 - A few additional players may arise with the new approvals and interim plan
- Next Board meeting 9/14/20, the approval/discussion of a competition schedule will be presented
- Per Mid Penn guidelines first date of competition cannot be before 9/25/20
- We are following and adhering to Mid Penn guidelines for return to play
- Looking at team pictures the week on 9/21/20 with VJM
 - Possibly have VJM take individual photos and then digitally comprise a team photo from individual photos
 - Need to locate the uniform storage (Linda Bonness may have details on this)
- In terms on video footage of games
 - District considering a plan to livestream all games
 - As a team look to identify a parent/student willing to video games to provide highlights for players, game film review, and potential recruiting highlights (Leslye

Garlin will follow up on possible students to assist in filming)

- Also explore what other athletic teams are doing in the district for film

Additional points of discussion reviewed:

- Backpacks for players, we should have enough with regard to the numbers remaining and the expected numbers of players to be retained on the team
 - Susan Lee will continue to make the bag tags
- Apparel order will be distributed to players and families after the 9/14/20 School Board Meeting
- Membership Dues/forms
 - Cost \$70.00
 - Handed out to players at practice and collected at the following practice
 - Email parents indicating membership forms will be coming home
- Consider hosting our Senior Day on Saturday, 10/3 playing Newport
- We will not host any concessions to minimize person to person contact and promote face coverings
- Consider a Breast Cancer Game in October with raffles/prizes

- After the 9/14/20 School Board Meeting we will move forward with identifying Committee Chairs/members to assist with the season special events
 - Breast Cancer game
 - Senior Day (9-12 total seniors)
 - Possible Meals for away games
 - We will need to determine if this will be permitted within the guidelines
- Move forward with the SCFH Boathouse jackets after players are identified
- Athletic trainers have to be reassigned/rehired per (contract), currently applications are being received and approved by athletics.
