Subject: Interim Financial Statement Report as of April 30, 2024				

Executive Summary:

The Interim Financial Statement Report provides an estimate for the Fiscal Year 2023-24 tenmonth period ending April 30, 2024. This report includes an interim statement of revenues and expenditures for all appropriated funds (i.e., General Fund, Food Service Fund, and Debt Service Fund.)

- General Fund Revenues realized total 71.1% and actual expenditures total 77.3% of the budget which are covered with fund balance reserves.
- Food Service Fund Revenues realized total 95.2% of the budget while actual expenditures total 84.5%.
- Debt Service Fund The total expenditures for the year are \$43.1 million, which account
 for the annual August interest payment and the February principal and interest payment. In
 addition, the District defeased \$7,335,000 of Series 2016 Unlimited Tax Refunding Bonds
 in February 2024. The cost of the defeasance was \$7,733,567, resulting in debt service
 savings of \$2,191,001.
- Tax Revenue and Collections Tax collections as of April 30, 2024, total \$107.1 million or 97.1%, but are lower than the prior year due to Senate Bill 2 passed during the 88th Legislative session, which provides school district property tax relief through tax rate compression and an increase in the homestead exemption from \$40,000 to \$100,000. The difference in local tax revenue is made up with state funding.
