BUILDING SCHEDULE

- School starts at 7:40 am and ends at 2:43 pm. Students may arrive at 7:25 am and report directly to the Commons.
- Bus students are dismissed at 2:43pm and walkers/car riders at 2:50 pm.
- Your child will have 5 core subjects and 2 encores a day.
- KAMS runs on an A-F letter day cycle. The day of the cycle determines the student's advisory and encore classes.
- After homeroom students go to advisory. Advisory is used for academic support, enrichment, band, chorus, social emotional learning, and club days.

ATTENDANCE

- Students that arrive after 7:40 am must sign-in at the office. Every fourth tardy results in an after school detention.
- Excessive unexcused/unlawful absences will result in truancy procedures.
- Please call the KAMS office to report your child's absence by 9:00 am. A written excuse explaining your child's absence is required for every absence.
- If your child has an early dismissal from school, you must provide a written note. Your child must bring that note to the office prior to, or during homeroom.

THINGS TO KNOW:

- Students will receive an agenda book to help with organization. It also serves as a hall pass and includes the student handbook. If lost, there is a replacement cost of \$5.00
- Lunches are grade level
- Students will have two lockers. One outside of their homeroom and a gym locker. Combination locks will be given for both. If lost, there is a replacement cost of \$5.00.
- Backpacks stay in lockers.
- Cellphones are permitted in school but must remain on silent in lockers.
- Each student is assigned a district Chromebook. Students are expected to take care and appropriately use their Chromebook at all times. Damage or misuse of the Chromebook could result in repair costs and/or disciplinary actions.
- Paper copies of report cards are issued quarterly and available on PowerSchool.
