  - b. Laurette Legon was elected Chair for a term of four years starting January 2023 and ending December 2026.
3. CTE Update
  - a. Onslow CTE Local Plan (2-year)
    1. Mandated by the Federal Government according to Perkins 5 Legislation.
    2. North Carolina mirrors federal legislation
    3. Submitted Summer 2022.
    4. Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment.
    5. Expansion Plan
    6. Credentials
      - a. According to Will Laine, the credential potential report valued around \$350,000 for the district. This would be for a single attempt by CTE students in all program areas for state-recognized credentials.
      - b. Onslow CTE received \$150,000 in credential funding from the state.
      - c. Anticipating the same amount of funding for this year.
      - d. Detailed credential attainment will be provided during the “Pipeline” monthly meetings.

      - a. Event to be held at Coastal Carolina Community College.
      - b. Job Fair will be moved to the courtyard for more exposure.

- d. Career & Technical Student Organizations
1. SkillsUSA State Leadership Conference April 27-29, 2022.
    - a. Richlands High School represented Onslow County and North Carolina at the 2022 SkillsUSA National Leadership and Skills Conference. Each student competed against the first-place winner from each state. Congratulations to the following students for an outstanding performance
      - i. **Maggie Adams** – National Winner – Bronze Medal in Practical Nursing (advisor Mrs. Mary Lanier)
      - ii. **Ayden Quinn** – 15th place in Architectural Drafting
      - iii. **Vanessa Bigford** – 6th place in Medical Assisting
      - iv. **Karly Jarman** – 12th place in Basic Health Care Skills
    - b. Ken Brown (RHS) was recognized as the Region 2 SkillsUSA Advisor of the Year and was a top five finalist for the National SkillsUSA Advisor of the Year.
- e. CTE Summer Career Accelerator
1. June 13-30, 2022
  2. Middle school rising 8<sup>th</sup> graders
    - a. Star Jobs Construction trades, health sciences, Ag/Food/Hospitality
    - b. Swansboro HS, Dixon HS, Richlands HS, Jacksonville HS
    - c. Students spent a week in each program cluster then rotated to the next for a total of three weeks.
    - d. Three days of hands-on activities in the classroom
    - e. One day of a field trip experience pertaining to their program area.
  3. High School Credential Recovery
    - a. Three weeks were allocated for students that did not obtain the state recognized credential for a CTE class they took during the previous years.
    - b. Culinary Arts – ServSafe
    - c. Automotive – Automotive Service Excellence (ASE)
  4. High School Summer Internship
    - a. Dates: June 13 – July 22, 2022
    - b. Minimum of 120 hours of on-the-job training with employers.
    - c. Minimum of 15 hours required for orientation, work-based learning instruction, and credential attainment.
