8. Print and sign, or digitally sign, and return to Cristo Rey in person or by emailing frontoffice@cristoreyseattle.org

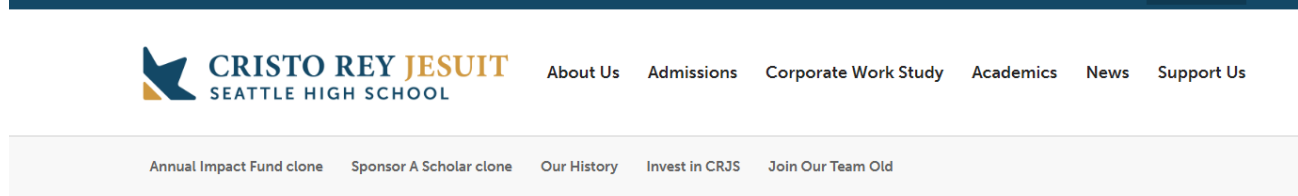

Let me know how this idea sounds like and we can get into the details.

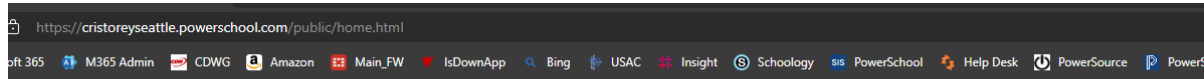

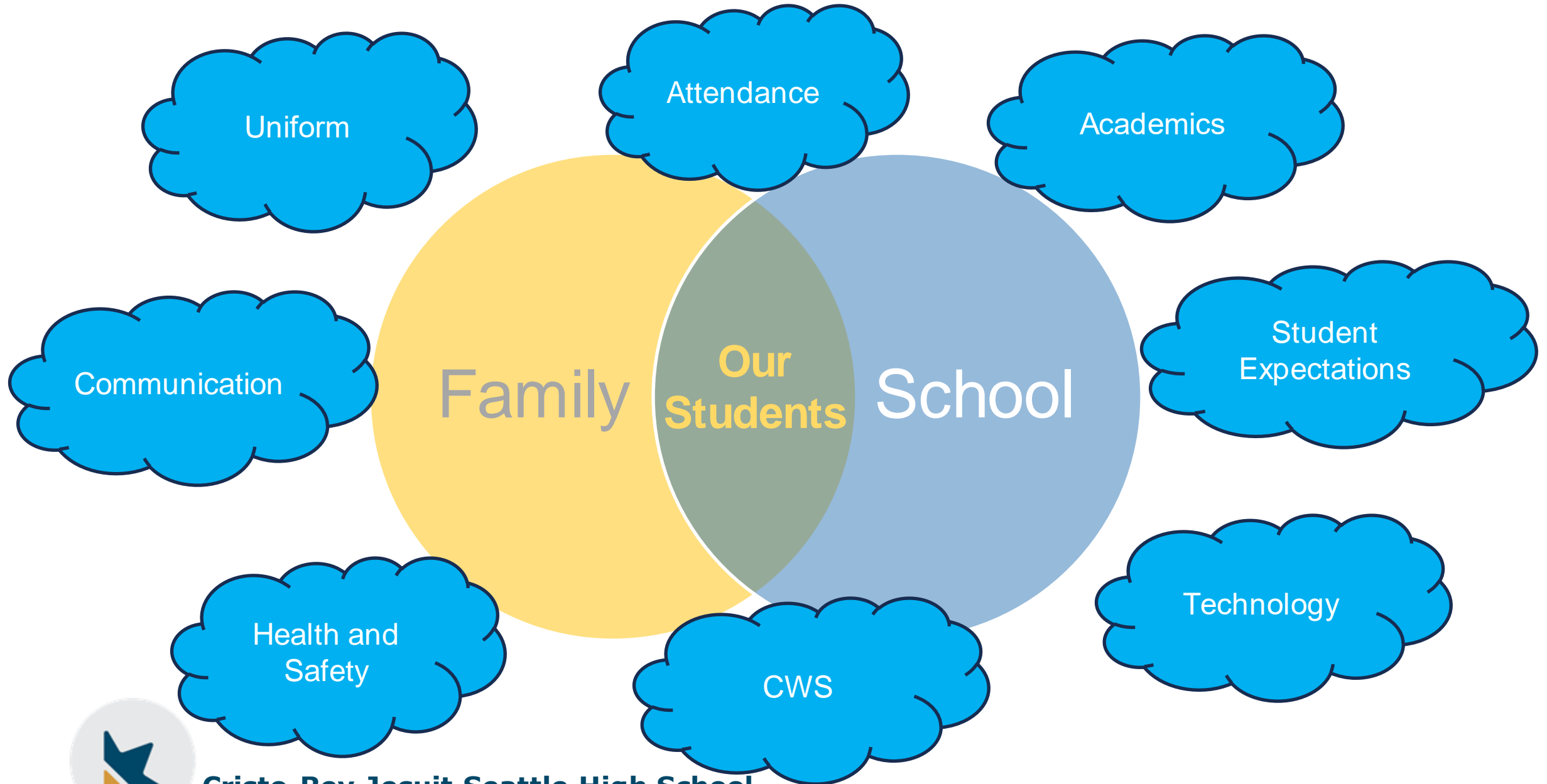
Homework Policy
