- » Full-day and half-day camps are available.
- » Early care, lunch, and aftercare are available for an additional fee.
- Early care: 7:30-9 a.m., \$55 per week
- Lunch: \$40 per week (includes supervision)
- Aftercare: 4-5:30 p.m., \$55 per week
- » Camps are closed once capacity is met, so register early!

Cancellation/Withdrawal Policy: BGA reserves the right to cancel a camp if a minimum number of participants do not sign up for the camp. A full refund will be given in the event of such cancellation. If after registering your student for a camp you withdraw your student, a registration fee equal to 1/3 the cost of the camp will be charged. If the camp/clinic withdrawal is received less than two weeks prior to the start of camp, the processing fee is 50% of the cost of the camp. Once the camp has started, we cannot issue any refunds.

Throwers are welcome but not required to bring any implements. BGA will provide the implements for this camp (shot put, discus, any med balls, bands, etc.). We will plan to split our time between shot put and discus each day, and have a mock meet on the fifth and final day.

Needs: Throwing shoes are completely optional; a pair of closed-toe, closed-back tennis shoes, sneakers, or Converse will do (prefer a flat, smooth sole), bottle of water, and any other sunscreen, hat, sunglasses (as needed).
