Attendance Zone Creation & Realignment

- The opening of Woodland Elementary School will require the creation of a new attendance area
- Provides the district an opportunity to address the capacity issues at several nearby schools
- This can be a difficult process for students and their families, so we want to provide adequate time for a possible change is schools

Please Note:

The creation of a new attendance zone for Woodland Elementary would be for the 2025-2026 school year



Considerations

- School capacity
- Student population growth trends
- Instructional programming
- Transportation efficiency and student travel times
- Geographical relationship of the student's home to the school
- Community considerations
 - Maintaining, to the extent possible, cohesive neighborhoods
 - Impact on neighborhoods that have been redistricted in the past
 - Feeder school patterns



The Redistricting Process

- On October 3, 2023, the Board directed staff to work with our partners at OREd to create a new attendance zone for Woodland Elementary
- Staff presents a new attendance zone map for the Board's consideration
- Staff seeks public comment
- Final adjustments are made based on feedback from the public and presented to the Board for consideration




The Redistricting Process


Four current schools will be affected by the opening of Woodland Elementary:

School	Current Capacity Status
Morton	102%
Queens Creek	113%
Silverdale	122%
Swansboro	94%



Old vs. New Attendance Zones






Proposed Morton Attendance Zone






Proposed Queens Creek Attendance Zone






Proposed Silverdale Attendance Zone





Four existing schools will be affected by the opening of Woodland Elementary:

School	Current Capacity Status	Capacity Status After Realignment
Morton	102%	77%
Queens Creek	113%	84%
Silverdale	122%	82%
Swansboro	94%	84%
Woodland	-	81%

There were be no impact on middle or high school attendance zones
