

### **Solicitation by Outside Agencies**

Students will not be exploited by the distribution of materials for the purpose of advertising or promoting private business.

Materials or activities containing references to private business, but which serve to advance the instructional programs of the district, may receive permission for distribution or participation by students if, in the opinion of the Superintendent of Schools or designee, such distribution or participation is primarily instructional in nature.

Nonprofit charity or civic organizations may involve students in promotions or fund-raising activities if prior permission is received from the Superintendent of Schools or designee. The Superintendent or designee will review each request to determine the potential benefit to students, the nature of the organization, and the potential disruption to the school day.

The district reserves the right to deny any non-school organization's request for distribution of materials to students or to post information regarding meetings or activities within school buildings. The district's *Ad-Ventures for Kids*, which allows for paid advertising that can be used by private businesses, may be an appropriate venue for this type of distribution.

The district's internal mail distribution system may not be utilized by private business to contact district personnel or students except as specifically authorized in this policy.

Principals have the authority to deny non-school organizations access to school or faculty bulletin boards or to prohibit the distribution of information to faculty or students that has not received prior approval.
