Dino and Kadesh came to teach kindergarten about the continents using songs and dancing!





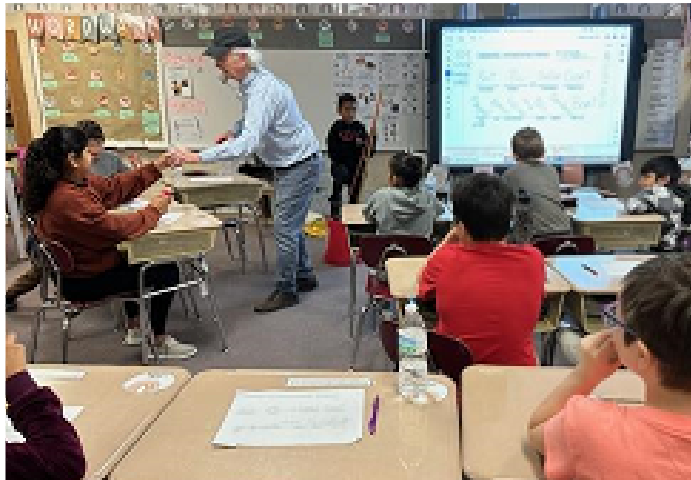
