



About Ursuline Academy

An Independent Catholic college preparatory school sponsored by the Ursuline Sisters, the Academy is the oldest continuously operating school in Dallas and the oldest all-girls school in Texas. This year Ursuline Academy is celebrating its Sesquicentennial, honoring an extraordinary 150-year history of academic excellence, innovation, and service.

Ursuline Academy is proud of the active participation of parents, students, faculty, staff, and alumnae. The community's passion and commitment create a special atmosphere where everyone feels valued and supported. The Academy takes immense pride in its academic and programmatic innovation, which is seamlessly integrated with the school's rich traditions. This approach fosters a love for learning, cultivates leadership skills, and instills the core value of Serviam (I will serve). Students and alumnae excel academically, and embrace a sense of sisterhood, forming lifelong connections and supporting one another throughout their journeys.

The Academy's mission is deeply rooted in the Ursuline heritage, which traces back to the founding of the Ursuline Sisters by St. Angela Merici in 1535. St. Angela envisioned the important roles that women could play in the Church and the world, and her mission spread throughout Europe. In 1639, the Ursulines became the first women's religious order to establish a presence in the New World, and in 1874, six pioneering Sisters founded Ursuline Academy in the then-frontier town of Dallas.





Today at Ursuline, enrollment reflects a diverse community of 880+ girls in grades 9-12. A dedicated 170-member faculty and staff advances an exceptional academic program that fosters critical thinking, creative problem-solving, and a passion for exploration. While maintaining academic rigor, Ursuline Academy empowers young women to become compassionate leaders in a rapidly evolving global society. The interdisciplinary curriculum promotes cultural awareness and the development of global competencies, aligning with the social teachings of the Catholic Church. As part of its commitment to going beyond borders, Ursuline Academy has established educational and cultural exchanges with 11 schools in countries worldwide.

Enthusiastic community support has enabled Ursuline to thrive and accomplish significant milestones, notably the recent successful conclusion of *The Campaign for Ursuline*: Act, Move, Believe, raising over 85 million dollars and funding a transformational campus expansion and extensive renovations. A recognized leader in educational technology, the Academy has been named a Microsoft Showcase School, one of only 36 in the U.S. and the only one in Texas.

Ursuline Academy will continue to build upon its strong legacy through ongoing investment in faculty, the campus, and programs to educate the whole student, providing an exceptional and well-rounded education that is academically strong, values-oriented, and faith-centered.
