That would allow time for evaluations and a meeting before the end of the school year. (You can also choose to wait, you'll just be likely to have evaluations and a meeting over the summer.) You can initiate a referral by sending a short letter explaining your concerns to Ms. Carpanzano (for RSS students) or Mr. Burg (for MS/HS students).
- E. Pupil Services introduced an online parent portal last month, to share meeting invitations, consent documents, and evaluation reports with parents. The implementation seems to be going well.
- F. Pupil Services is starting to project its layers of services for next year, such as ICT's, self-contained special classes, pull-outs, and teacher aides, which will all ultimately result from the CSE and 504 meetings. It is possible the Kindergarten ICT might be replaced by other service models. It is also possible that a fifth grade ICT might be added.
