

SHAC Committee Minutes

12/14/2021, 4:00 pm

Speakers:

Katie Snyder – Anger Management Programming for DAEP, various schools throughout the district .

Ms. Snyder discussed service provided to DAEP students and branching out to other school services, including providing anger management courses, including Turtle Magic for Students 3-6, managing your Anger for Children, Ages 6-12, and Teen Anger Management Education for 12 and up. She reviewed material presented, and has had the opportunity to work with DAEP students, as well as Northwest, East, Woodland Heights, and Coggin. She went over the schedule for the new year, with intention to focus on specific campuses to ensure maximum impact. Ms. Snyder also provided parenting calendars to the group, and spoke about the availability of parenting workshops, Safe Exchange, and Children in the Middle services for families within in the community.

Wendy Hamilton – Texas Agrilife Extension

Ms. Hamilton reviewed Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) resources, meal plan, and budgeting service available to low-income families. The SNAP program already works closely with our BISD Headstart program. 21% of Headstart families are identified as struggling with poverty and 63.93% of BISD students are identified as economically disadvantaged. Agrilife Extension provides an 8 week program to encourage physical activity, healthy eating and healthy living. See provided pamphlet.

Mitch Moore – RFP Menu Planning

SFE representatives who attended the SHAC meeting were asked to leave the meeting before discussion of menu planning took place as it would be a conflict of interest for them to participate. The 2022 – 2023 school year menu planning was discussed to be included in our RFP that will be sent out in January or February of 2022. Mr. Moore explained that the committee needed to develop menus to be used for the first 21 days of the 2022-2023 school year. Committee members discussed several options and menu items. Breakfast, lunch, and snack menus were approved by the committee to be included in the RFP. Mr. Moore will include the menus adopted in the RFP. Once proposals are received back, the committee will meet again to discuss the selection of a FSMC.
