appointed Chad Newton as the Interim Athletic Director effective
August 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. There were 5 ayes and 0

A motion was made by T. Hollingsworth, seconded by N. Maiura,
be it:

**7-12 Special Education
Teacher Scott Lane**

“RESOLVED” that the Board of Education of the
Stockbridge Valley Central School District, pursuant to Section
2509 of the Education Law and in compliance with Part 30.3
of the Rules of the Board of Regents, upon the recommendation of
the Superintendent of Schools, does hereby appoint Scott Lane
to the position of Special Education Teacher in the tenure area of Special
Education Grades 7-12 for a probationary period of four years, to commence
on September 1, 2015, and to expire on September 1, 2019 (unless extended
in accordance with the law). This expiration date is tentative and conditional
only. Except to the extent required by the applicable provisions of Section
3012³ of the education Law, in order to be granted tenure the teacher must
receive composite or overall annual performance review ratings pursuant to
Section 3012-c and/or 3012-d of the Education Law of either effective or highly
effective in at least three (3) of the four (4) preceding years, and if the teacher
receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the
probationary period the teacher shall not be eligible for tenure at that time.
Mr. Lane will hold a valid New York State Certificate permitting him to serve
in the field of Special Education Grades 7-12, AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED
that during his first year of this appointment be paid at Step 1, Base Salary
\$39,469 plus Master’s. There were 6 ayes and 0 nays. The motion carried.

On the recommendation of Rita Kenyon and on a motion
by B. Reaves, seconded by N. Maiura, the Board went into
Executive Session at 4:43 p.m. to discuss matters pertaining to the
Superintendent Search. There were 6 ayes and 0 nays. The motion carried.
