Erin Belanger, Resignation

A motion was made by J. Strain, seconded by K. Guinto,

“RESOLVED” that the Board of Education of the
Stockbridge Valley Central School District, pursuant to Section
2509 of the Education Law and in compliance with Part 30.3
of the Rules of the Board of Regents, upon the recommendation of
the Superintendent of Schools, does hereby appoint Rachel Leach
to the position of K-12 Music Teacher in the tenure area of K-12 Music
Teacher for a probationary period of four years, to commence on
September 1, 2021, and to expire on August 31, 2025 (unless extended
in accordance with the law). This expiration date is tentative and conditional
only. Except to the extent required by the applicable provisions of Section
3012³ of the education Law, in order to be granted tenure the teacher must
receive composite or overall annual performance review ratings pursuant to
Section 3012-c and/or 3012-d of the Education Law of either effective or highly
effective in at least three (3) of the four (4) preceding years, and if the teacher
receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the
probationary period the teacher shall not be eligible for tenure at that time.
Ms. Leach will hold a valid New York State Certificate permitting her to serve
in the field of K-12 Music AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during her
first year of this appointment be paid at Step 1, \$46,516 plus Masters. There were
6 ayes and 0 nays. The motion carried.

On a motion K. Guinto, seconded by J. Renner, the Board entered into Executive Session at 7:16 p.m. to discuss the superintendent search. There were 6 ayes and 0 nays. The motion carried.
