Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, and on a motion by J. Renner, seconded by K. Guinto, the Board accepted the Resignation of Tom Walcek, Cleaner as of August 31, 2020. There were 6 ayes and 0 nays. The motion carried.

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, and on a motion by J. Strain, seconded by K. Guinto, the Board gave approval to proceed with the hiring of new staff due to the COVID-19 regulations. There were 5 ayes and 0 nays (H. Bingel abstained.) The motion carried.

On a motion by J. Renner, seconded by H. Bingel, the meeting adjourned at 8:36 p.m. There were 6 ayes and 0 nays. The motion carried.
